		<b>NETWORK TECHNICIAN - Functional Responsibility:</b> Applies technical knowledge to maintain, troubleshoot, and repair electronic circuitry or computer problems that typically cannot be solely solved by referencing manufacturers' manuals or similar documents. Knowledgeable in the use and operation of test equipment to diagnose electronic circuits may be required. Generally exercises independent judgment in performing tasks but work may be reviewed by supervisors for compliance with accepted practices and safety procedures. May provide technical guidance to lower level technicians.
Level 1	MZK01	High School diploma with at least 2 years of relevant experience. Relevant college or trade school education and/or hardware certifications may be substituted for experience on a case-by-case basis.
Level 2	MZK02	High School diploma with at least 6 years of relevant experience. Relevant college or trade school education and/or hardware certifications may be substituted for experience on a case-by-case basis.

Uses knowledge of LAN/WAN systems to help design and install internal and external networks. Tests and evaluates network systems to eliminate problems and make improvements. Requires a bachelor's degree in area of specialty and 2-5 years of experience in the field or in a related area. Familiar with standard concepts, practices, and procedures within a particular field. Relies on limited experience and judgment to plan and accomplish goals. Performs a variety of tasks. Works under general supervision. A certain degree of creativity and latitude is required. Typically reports to a supervisor.
